## Enrollment (Fall 2019)

Fordham University enrolls 16,972 students. Of the 9,767 undergraduates, 4,649 live in University-managed housing. The entering freshman class consists of 2,270 students. There are 7,205 graduate and professional students, of whom 144 live in University-managed housing. The University consists of nine schools.

## Campuses (Fall 2019)

**Rose Hill**, the original campus, is situated on 85 acres in the north Bronx. About 7,179 undergraduates and graduates attend, with 3,425 living in University housing.

**The Lincoln Center Campus** was established in 1961 on eight landscaped acres adjacent to Lincoln Center for the Performing Arts. About 9,376 professional and undergraduate students attend, with 1,368 living in University-operated housing. This campus is also home to PCS's 'incubator' graduate programs enrolling 103 students, and to the Institute of American Language and Culture (IALC), which 32 students attend.
